Revised Lane Configuration of I-95 Northbound Exit 51 On-Ramp in East Haven Scheduled to Begin July 26

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing that effective Tuesday morning, July 26, at 5:00a.m., the Exit 51 On-Ramp to I-95 Northbound in East Haven will be in a revised lane configuration.

The revised configuration will carry ramp traffic along the far right side of the newly constructed I-95 Northbound between Exit 51 and Exit 52, and ramp traffic will merge with Exit 52 On-Ramp traffic immediately east of the current Exit 52 On-Ramp. Traffic will then follow the currently established lane for the Exit 52 On-Ramp, which outflows into its own lane on the Saltonstall Bridge.

This temporary configuration will be in effect for approximately 6 weeks and is necessary to facilitate work on Contract C1 of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program.

Contract C1 (between the eastern end of the Lake Saltonstall Bridge and the New Haven/East Haven town line) is scheduled to be completed by August 2006.
