Lane Shift on I-95 Southbound near Exit 50 (Woodward Avenue) in New Haven Scheduled to Begin October 11

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing that a lane shift on I-95 Southbound near Exit 50 (Woodward Avenue) in New Haven is scheduled to begin on October 11. The existing southbound lanes will be shifted to the north **beginning Thursday, October 11 at 9:00p.m.** until further notice; the shift will place traffic onto newly constructed pavement and is necessary to reconstruct existing southbound travel lanes.

The work is part of Contract C2 of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program. Contract C2 is located in New Haven and consists of the reconstruction of approximately one mile of I-95 just east of Stiles Street in New Haven to the New Haven/East Haven town line. Construction is scheduled to be completed in June 2009.
