### **Lane Shift on I-95 Northbound Between Exit 50 (Woodward Avenue) and Exit 51 (Frontage Road) in New Haven Scheduled for November 30, 2007**

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing that a lane shift on I-95 Northbound between Exit 50 (Woodward Avenue) and Exit 51 (Frontage Road) in New Haven is scheduled for Friday, **November 30, from 9:00p.m. to 6:00a.m.**, weather permitting. **In case of cancellation due to weather, the work will be rescheduled for the week of December 3, 2007.**

I-95 Northbound traffic will be shifted to the left onto a newly constructed section of road to allow for the next stage of construction. Three through lanes for northbound traffic are being restored as part of this stage shift, which will be in effect until further notice.

The work is part of Contract C2 of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program. Contract C2 is located in New Haven and consists of the reconstruction of approximately one mile of I-95 just east of Stiles Street in New Haven to the New Haven/East Haven town line. Construction is scheduled to be completed in June 2009.
