### **Nighttime Lane Closures on I-95 Southbound Between Exit 54 (Branford) and Exit 52 (East Haven) Scheduled to Occur from April 14 through April 22, 2008**

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing that nighttime lane closures will occur on I-95 Southbound between Exit 54 (Branford) and Exit 52 (East Haven) on **Mondays through Thursdays between 7:00p.m. and 6:00a.m. beginning April 14 through April 22, 2008**, weather permitting. In case of inclement weather, the work may also occur on Friday nights after 8:00p.m.

The work is part of Contract D1 of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program. Contract D1 is located in Branford and East Haven and consists of milling and final paving of I-95 Southbound between Exit 54 and Exit 52. Additional work consists of sound wall installation, rights of way fencing, plantings, and milling/paving and joint work for Lake Saltonstall Bridge. Construction is scheduled to be completed in November 2008.
