Lane Shift on I-95 Southbound near Exit 50 (Woodward Avenue) in New Haven Scheduled for June 18

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing that a lane shift on I-95 Southbound near Exit 50 (Woodward Avenue) in New Haven is scheduled for June 18. The existing southbound lanes will be shifted to the left approximately 20 feet and will place traffic onto newly constructed pavement. The work to complete the traffic shift will occur at night and lane closures will be in effect on **Monday, June 18 from 9:00p.m. to 6:00a.m.**

The work is part of Contract C2 of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program. Contract C2 is located in New Haven and consists of the reconstruction of approximately one mile of I-95 just east of Stiles Street in New Haven to the New Haven/East Haven town line. Construction is scheduled to be completed in June 2009.
