Nighttime Lane Closures on I-95 Northbound Between Exit 46 in New Haven and Exit 51 in East Haven Scheduled to Begin July 9

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing that emergency deck repairs on the existing Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q) Bridge are scheduled to begin the night of Monday, July 9, 2007. Work will begin on I-95 Northbound between Exit 46 in New Haven and Exit 51 in East Haven.

Nightly lane closures can be expected **Mondays through Thursdays from 10:00p.m. to 6:00a.m.** After repairs are completed on the I-95 Northbound side of the bridge, repairs will be performed on the I-95 Southbound side.

The work is part of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program and is being performed under a \$1.5-million contract awarded to Blakeslee Arpaia Chapman, Inc., of Branford, Connecticut. Work is scheduled to be completed in late September 2007.
