

# I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program



## CONSTRUCTION ANNOUNCEMENT

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## **New Lanes Now Open on I-95 Between New Haven and East Haven**

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing that all additional lanes related to the expansion of I-95 in East Haven are now open. This includes I-95 Southbound and I-95 Northbound as well as North Frontage Road, South Frontage Road and North High Street. The construction is part of Contract C1 of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program.

Contract C1 includes the widening of I-95 to three travel lanes in each direction with full inside and outside shoulders, the installation of median concrete barriers and improvements to interchanges between the eastern end of the Lake Saltonstall Bridge and the New Haven/East Haven town line.

Temporary lane closures may still occur during off-peak hours to perform work necessary to complete the project. However, during summer weekends, no lane closures related to construction activity will occur on I-95 from 12:01PM on Fridays through 12:01AM on Mondays. Summer weekends run between Memorial Day and Labor Day (Monday, September 4, 2006). The number of lanes available on I-95 during these hours will not be reduced.

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## **PROGRAM UPDATE**

The I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program continues to progress. Contract C1 (between the eastern end of the Lake Saltonstall Bridge and the New Haven/East Haven town line) is scheduled to be completed by August 2006. Contract C2 (the reconstruction of approximately one mile of I-95 just east of Stiles Street in New Haven to the New Haven/East Haven town line) began construction in September 2005 and is scheduled to be completed in June 2009. Contract E1/E (the reconstruction of the I-95/I-91/Route 34 interchange) is scheduled to be completed in November 2014. Contract B (the construction of a new 10-lane Pearl Harbor Memorial Bridge) is scheduled to begin in May 2007 and be completed in November 2014. In addition, as part of the I-95 Program, new or improved Shore Line East Stations were completed in Clinton (July 2005), Branford (August 2005) and Guilford (November 2005). Work on the Madison station is scheduled to be completed in Spring 2007; schedules are still to be determined for the Westbrook station.
