Permanent Closure of I-95 Northbound Exit 49 Off-Ramp and Opening of new Exit 50 Off-ramp in New Haven Scheduled to Occur By October 30

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing the permanent closing of the existing I-95 Northbound Exit 49 off-ramp (at Stiles Street), which will be replaced with the new Exit 50 off-ramp. The new Exit 50 off-ramp, which also replaces the existing Exit 50 off-ramp, will allow access to Woodward Avenue and Main Street and will allow access to Stiles Street via the new Waterfront Connector.

The closure of the Exit 49 off-ramp and opening of the new Exit 50 off-ramp is scheduled to occur by October 30, 2006. Additional information will be provided as the date approaches. This is another milestone for the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program.

The work is part of Contract C2 of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program. Contract C2 is located in New Haven and consists of the reconstruction of approximately one mile of I-95 just east of Stiles Street in New Haven to the New Haven/East Haven town line. Construction is scheduled to be completed in June 2009.
