

I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program



CONSTRUCTION ANNOUNCEMENT

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Advance Utility Work near I-95 Southbound and I-95 Northbound Over Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q) Bridge Scheduled to Begin August 31

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing that brief traffic stoppages and lane closures may occur on I-95 Southbound and I-95 Northbound over the Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q) Bridge between Exit 46 and Exit 51 **on Mondays through Thursdays between 10:00p.m. and 6:00a.m. beginning Tuesday, August 31.** This work is scheduled to occur through October and will occur weather permitting; in the case of inclement weather, work will be postponed until the following night.

Traffic on I-95 Northbound and I-95 Southbound between Exit 46 and Exit 51 may be halted for 5-10 minute intervals 3 or 4 times each night to facilitate the relocation of transmission lines. There may also be periodic lane closures.

This advance work is part of Contract B of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program and includes the construction of a new 10-lane Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q) Bridge. The entire project is scheduled to be completed in August 2012.
