Overhead Utility Work near Exit 54 on I-95 in Branford Scheduled for February 26 and February 27

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing that overhead utility work will occur adjacent to Exit 54 – Cedar Street on I-95 in Branford **between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 26 and between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on Friday, February 27.** This work is to facilitate the completion of the Todds Hill Road Bridge and new overhead utilities along Todds Hill Road.

Traffic on I-95 Northbound and I-95 Southbound between Exit 53 and Exit 54 will be halted for 5-10 minute intervals 3 times each day to protect drivers, passengers and pedestrians during the installation of new overhead cables.

The construction is part of Contract D of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program. Contract D includes the expansion of I-95 between Lake Saltonstall in East Haven and Exit 54 in Branford; construction is scheduled to be completed in Spring 2004.
