## No Lane Closures on I-95 During the Thanksgiving Holiday

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing that during the Thanksgiving holiday, no lane closures related to work on the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program and the expansion of the incident management system will occur. **Beginning Wednesday morning, November 22 at 6:00a.m. through Monday night, November 27 at 8:00p.m.,** all travel lanes on I-95 will be open to facilitate traffic flow during the holiday period.

### I-95 PROGRAM UPDATE

The I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program continues to progress.

Contract C1 (between the eastern end of the Lake Saltonstall Bridge and the New Haven/East Haven town line) was completed in August 2006.

Contract C2 (the reconstruction of approximately one mile of I-95 just east of Stiles Street in New Haven to the New Haven/East Haven town line) began construction in September 2005 and is scheduled to be completed in June 2009.

Contract E1/E (the reconstruction of the I-95/I-91/Route 34 interchange) is scheduled to be completed in November 2014.

Contract B (the construction of a new 10-lane Pearl Harbor Memorial Bridge) is scheduled to begin in October 2007 and be completed in November 2014.

In addition, as part of the I-95 Program, new or improved Shore Line East Stations were completed in Clinton (July 2005), Branford (August 2005) and Guilford (November 2005). Work on the Madison station is scheduled to be completed in Spring 2007; schedules will be determined for the Westbrook station.
