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## **Daytime Rock Blasting Near I-95 Exit 54 in Branford Extended through March 28**

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) is announcing that daytime rock blasting has been extended due to weather delays and will occur **between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. through Friday, March 28** near I-95 Exit 54 - Cedar Street in Branford. This work is to facilitate construction of the new Todds Hill Road Bridge and will occur weather permitting.

Traffic on I-95 northbound and I-95 southbound between Exit 53 and Exit 54 will be halted for 5-10 minute intervals 2 times each day to protect drivers, passengers and pedestrians to permit the rock blasting and subsequent inspection of roadways.

The construction is part of Contract D of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program. Contract D includes the expansion of I-95 between Lake Saltonstall in East Haven and Exit 54 in Branford and is scheduled for completion in December 2003.
